Your registration is complete when your enrolment file has been completed, paraphrased and signed (agreement and charter) - for the official and mandatory security meeting on **18 April 2019**.

NON-MOTORIZED DELEGATION

A non-motorized delegation is a delegation where no powered floats are involved. Most organizations participate on foot with banners, posters, flags, signs, mascots, bicycles, balloons, etc. - to be in the spotlight.

If you have crazier ideas, and there is a kind of rolling transportation, such as bicycles, trailer, Segways, etc. please state this at your registration. We will contact you as soon as possible to see what is possible and what is not.





MOTORIZED DELEGATION

A motorized delegation is a delegation with a vehicle. There are safety regulations for this type of delegation.

- Driver's license B(+E)
- Dimensions of a vehicle Height: max. 4 m
 Width: max. 2.55 m
 - Length: TBD
- Maximum permissible mass (MPM) up to 3500 kg
- Up to 8 passengers with a railing at a height of 1.10 m
- Cord carriers/stewards

PRICING?

If your organization participates on foot, this is completely free.

Below all prices for a motorized delegation:

- LGBTI+, non-profit association:
 €100
- Non-profit organization, public sector or political parties: €450
- There is an entry price for all commercial organizations.

Other costs?

- Use of electronically amplified music: €60
- Promotional sampling: €900

The Pride Village opens on the Kunstberg/Mont Des Arts this day and will be filled with the enormous number of visitors and participants that the Belgian Pride attracts each year. In the Pride Village visitors can party, dance, eat and drink to your heart's content.

The Pride Village has a number of features. All day there are amazing acts and (inter)national performances on the Pride Stage. The Pride Village has also the Women's Square, multiple bars and a food corner where a variety of food trucks allow visitors to taste culinary specialties from around the world.

Last but not least, there will be a market containing many LGBTI + organizations and partners.

STAND MARKET

As LGBTI + organization you can have a stand to introduce yourself to the visitors. This market aims to give visibility to the associations. Being creative is the way to stand out and exhibitors are advised to organize interactive activities with emphasis on education, prevention, etc. In addition, there will be informative stands by non-profit organizations who want to spread their ideas. Rainbow products will be sold from commercial stands. Pride partners also get the opportunity to represent themselves

Each site has a standard area of 3mx3m and a deposit will be charged per space. We also offer a logistics base package and an option for electricity. The logistics base package consists of one tent (3mx3m), one table and two chairs. In addition, the organization also provides an option for electricity.



FOODCORNER

This heaven of culinary delights is filled with specialties from all over the world. The organization only accepts food trucks, so no food tents.
